

Instructions for Qualatex® Spiders

To keep assembly time to a minimum, gather the materials and read through the instructions before beginning.

Mini Spider Balloon Topper

Labor: About 5 Minutes

Helium: About 15 cu. ft. (.425m³)

Materials:

1 3' (91cm) "Spiders & Webs" Diamond Clear Latex Balloon 96642

1 11" (28cm) Onyx Black Latex Balloon 43737

8 350Q Onyx Black Latex Balloons 44036

Qualatex BalloonRibbon™

Foam Wire

Wiggle Eyes

Cool Glue

Instructions:

1. Helium inflate the 3' "Spiders & Webs" balloon, tie, and attach to BalloonRibbon.

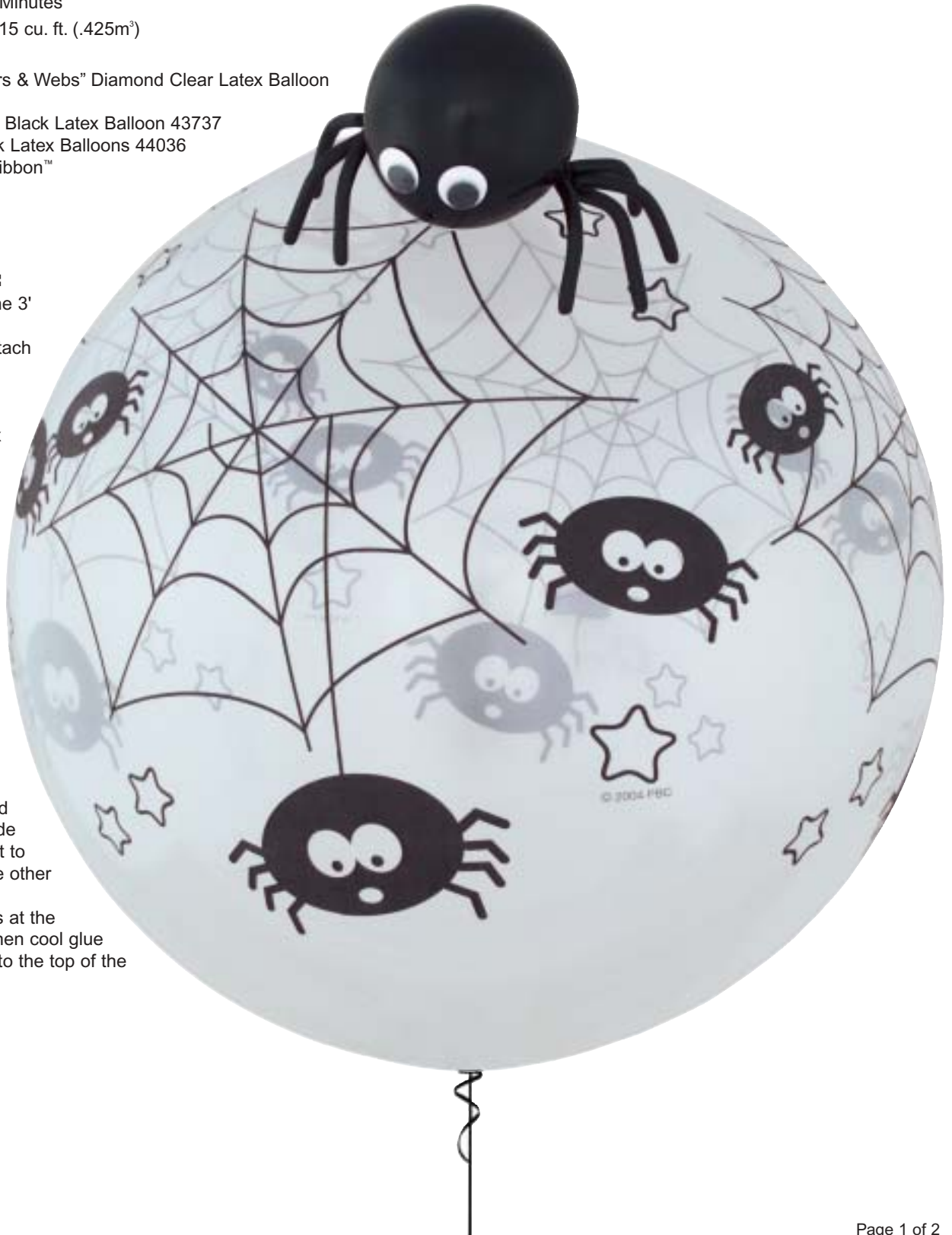
2. To make the Spider's "body," inflate an 11" Onyx Black balloon to 7" (18cm) and tie.

3. Make a "leg" by inserting a 6" (15cm) piece of foam wire into an uninflated Onyx Black 350Q.

Blow a puff of air into the balloon, then tie and trim any excess.

Repeat to make three more legs, tie all four legs together, trim any excess balloon, and cool glue to one side of the body. Repeat to add four legs to the other side.

4. Add wiggle eyes at the front of the body, then cool glue the body and legs to the top of the 3' balloon.



Chunky Spider

Labor: About 5 Minutes

Helium (Optional): About 10 cu. ft. (.283m³)

Materials:

1 3' (91cm) Onyx Black Latex Balloon 43981
1 16" (41cm) Onyx Black Latex Balloon 43858
8 350Q Onyx Black Latex Balloons 44036
Qualatex BalloonRibbon™
Black & White Paper
Adhesive Balloon Tab
Monofilament Line
Weight (Optional)
Spray Adhesive
Cool Glue

Instructions:

1. Inflate the 16" balloon to 15" (38cm) for the "head" and the 3' balloon to 2 1/2' (76cm) for the "body." Tie the two balloon necks together.
2. **If the Spider is helium-filled,** attach an adhesive balloon tab to the bottom of the 3' balloon, tie to monofilament line, and secure to a weight. **If air-filled,** attach an adhesive balloon tab to the top of the 3' balloon, then suspend the Spider with monofilament line after completion.
3. Fully inflate a 350Q, then release enough air to make the balloon about 24" (61cm), and knot. Repeat with the remaining 350Qs. Tie the 350Qs into duplets to make "legs." Wrap the duplets together to make an 8-balloon cluster.
4. Wrap the center knot of the legs around the knot between the head and body to secure.
5. Cut circles from black and white paper, then use spray adhesive to attach to the 16" balloon for "eyes" and a "nose."

TIPS

- Vary the size of the Chunky Spider using 5", 11", 16", and 24" balloons, depending on your needs.
- Use air-filled Chunky Spiders as Column toppers, and add helium-filled Spiders to Halloween bouquets and centerpieces.
- Increase the float time of helium-filled latex balloons by 25 times when you treat them with ULTRA HI-FLOAT™ balloon flight extender.
